The President's Reception will be held on Friday, March 27 from 6 - 8 pm at the [Bullock Texas State History Museum](#), located at 1800 N. Congress (the corner of Congress Ave. and MLK Blvd.), Austin, TX 78701. Enjoy this time to visit with friends. Dress should be casual – collared shirts, khakis, sundresses (no blazer or tie necessary). We will have appetizers, a bar and access to the three floors of museum exhibits. The museum's garage parking is free and easily accessible on the south side of the museum on 18th St. After parking, take the stairs or elevator to the ground floor and walk across the plaza to the glass entrance doors. The museum is within walking distance of the Hilton Garden Inn host hotel.

Directions and Parking at UT Austin

All attendees will park in the HCG ("Health Care Garage") on the same long block as the Health Discovery Building. The garage's address is 1601 Trinity, Bldg A. It is located on Trinity, just north of 15th St. Trinity is a one-way street from south to north, so enter from 15th St. Enter the garage, pull a ticket on the illuminated screen (green button), park in "visitor and patient parking" on levels 2-6. Walk to the north elevators. You are now in the Health Transformation Building. Take the elevator down to level 1. From the level 1 elevator lobby (orange walls), exit the glass doors and walk across the courtyard. Look for TSEPS signage. Veer left towards Trinity St and enter the HDB doors facing Trinity St.

To return to the parking garage, walk back across the courtyard and reverse these steps.

Exiting the Parking Garage: The gate will accept credit and debit cards. Put your ticket under the red light at a 45-degree angle. Fees are based on the duration of your stay. Keep your parking ticket and scan the QR code upon exit to pay. Roughly \$20 for a nine-hour day.

Risk Management Discounts

TMLT: Physicians insured with Texas Medical Liability Trust may earn a 3% discount for attending BOTH (2 hours total) presentations: “TMLT: **From Difficult to Dangerous: How to Handle Disruptive Patients**” and “OMIC: **Mitigating Anesthesia Risk for the OR Team.**” This discount will be applied to the physician’s next eligible policy period.
